



James E. Read, Ph.D.

Dr. James (Jim) Read is Executive Director of The Salvation Army Ethics Centre in Winnipeg, Associate Professor of Philosophy and Ethics at Booth College, and a Senior Policy Analyst for the Salvation Army's International Social Justice Commission.

Jim is a graduate of Glendon College, Toronto and the University of California at Los Angeles, which conferred the Ph.D. in Philosophy on him in 1988.

Dr. Read has provided ethics consultation on a wide variety of issues and written extensively for Salvation Army publications. He teaches a course in professional ethics for ministry which was designed with Salvation Army ministry particularly in mind. This course is now part of the regular CFOT curriculum in Canada & Bermuda, and via Booth College OnLine it has been available to students around the world. Dr. Read has been privileged to be the guest speaker at numerous Officers' Councils, Retreats and ethics conferences in Canada, Australia, Chile, Denmark, Finland, Sweden, and the United States.

Lifelong Salvationists, Jim and his wife Laurie (who retired in 2008 after more than a decade as a nurse manager at the Salvation Army Grace Hospital and Grace Hospice in Winnipeg) have been members of Heritage Park Temple for the past 25 years, and over that time they have held a variety of lay leadership positions.
